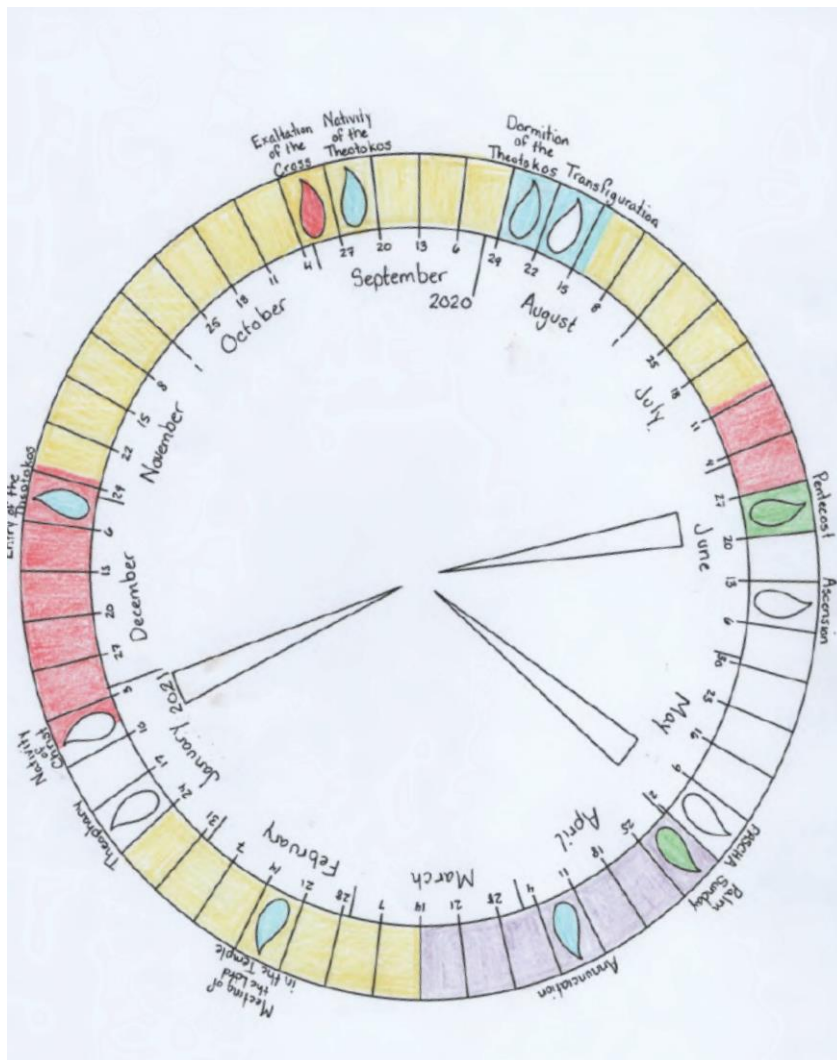


## Slides in this packet:

- 1) Golden arrows for the calendar. Instructions: laminate both the calendar and the sheet with arrows. Cut out an arrow. Punch a hole in the center of the calendar and the center of the circular portion of the arrow. Attach the arrow to the calendar with a brad.
- 2) Liturgical Calendar according to the Julian (Old) Calendar of the Orthodox Church with Feast Days written in (suggestion: color the calendar according to traditions in your church)
- 3) Liturgical Calendar according to the Julian (Old) Calendar of the Orthodox Church without feast days (suggestion: have older children look up the feast days and label them, color the calendar)
- 4) Liturgical Calendar without feast days or Nativity written in. Suitable for both Old and New Calendar Orthodox. (suggestion: look up feast days, write them in, color the calendar)
- 5) Circular Calendar with only months and dates of the Sundays of the Orthodox Year. (Note: Orthodox New Year is September 1 – so Liturgical Calendar starts on September 1.)

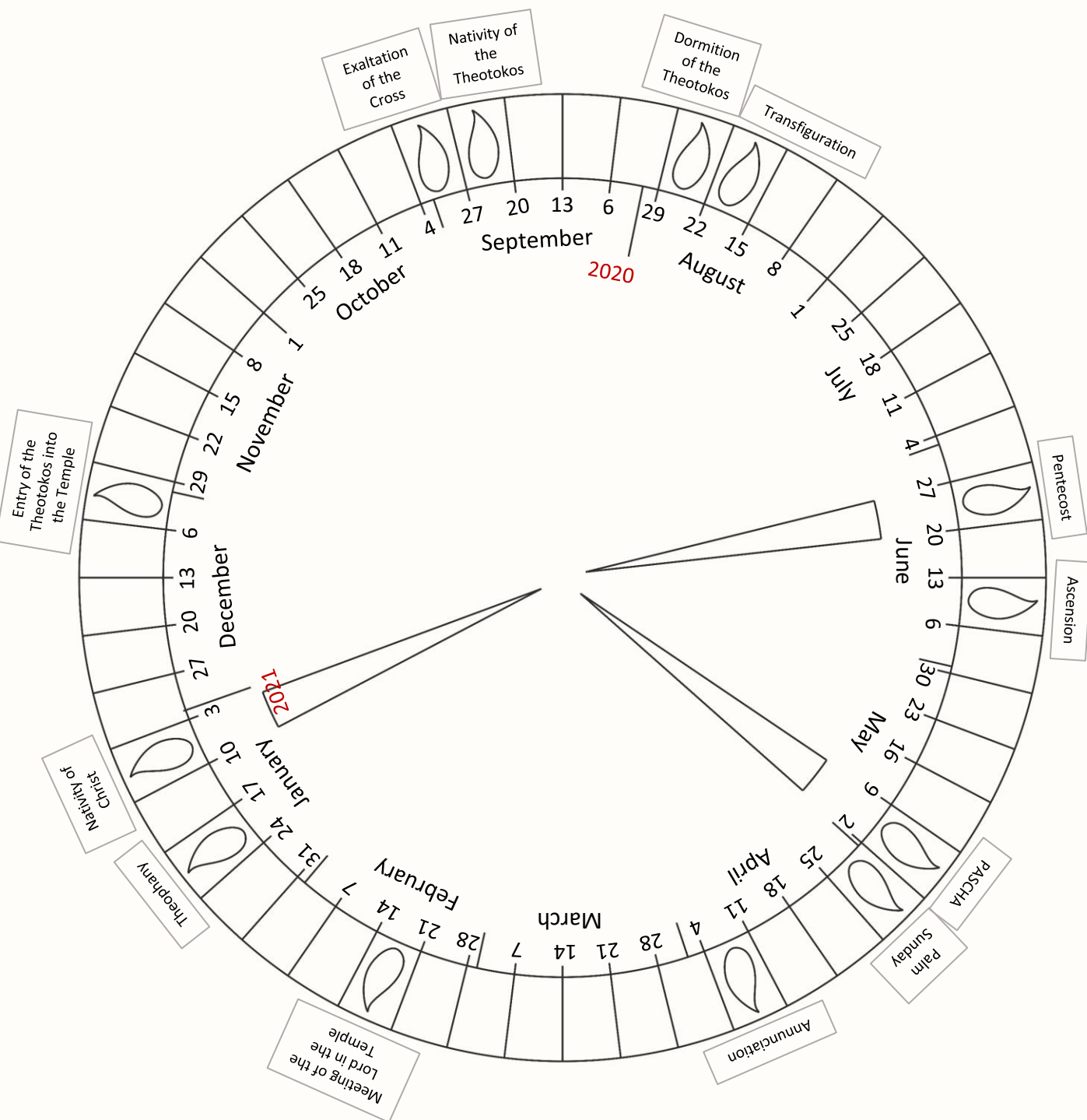

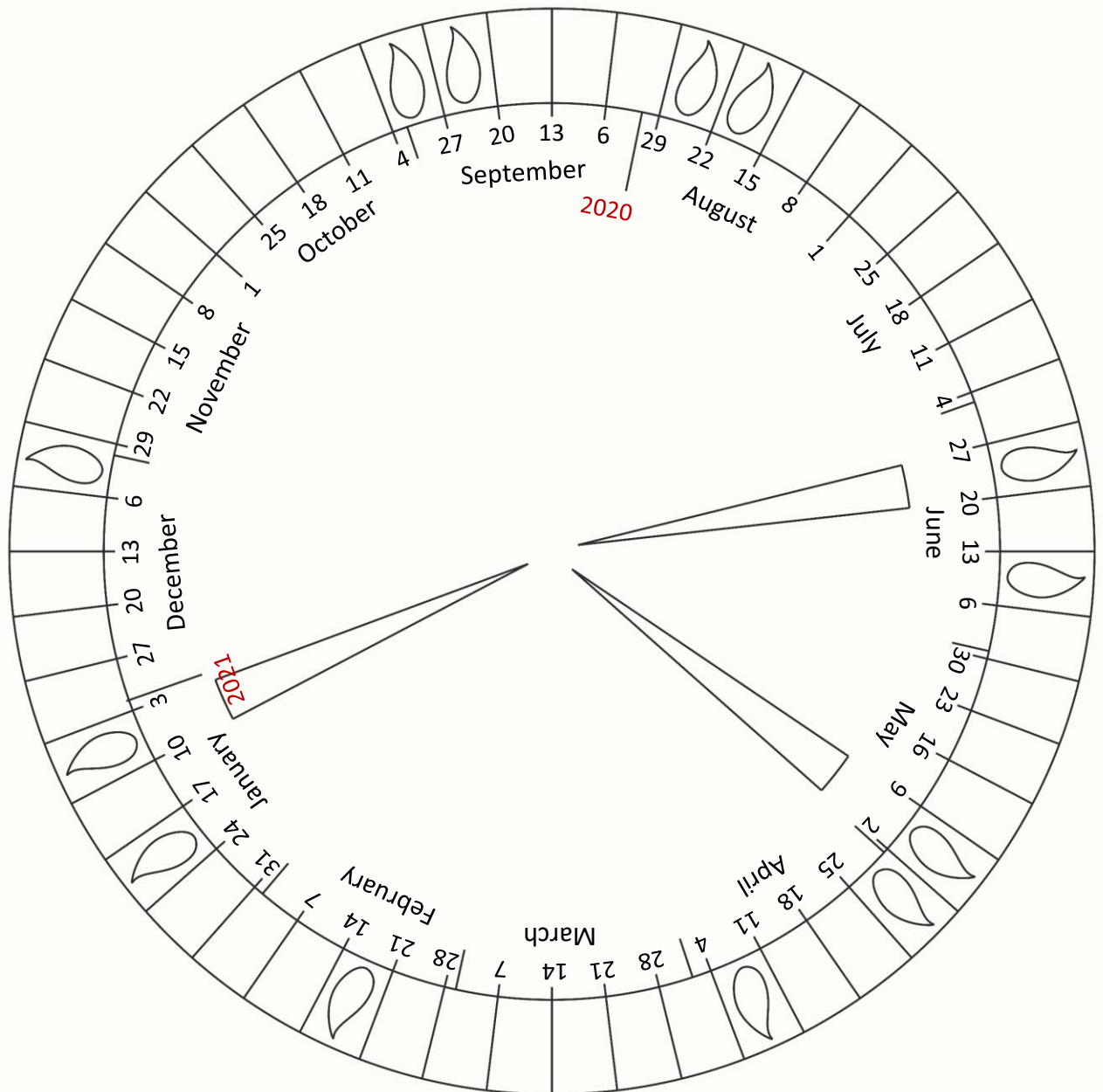

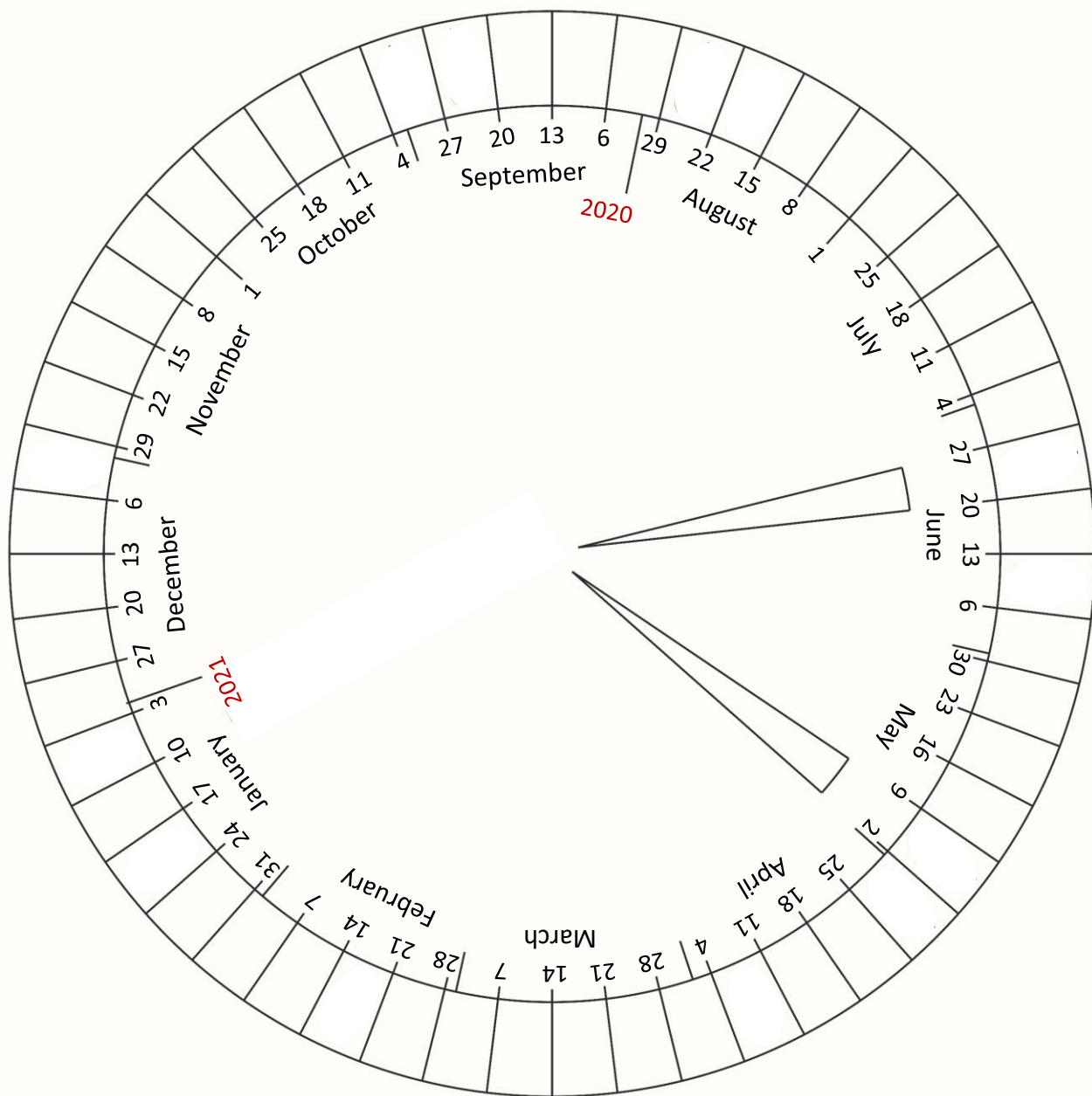
