WHO: Campers: 5 - 12 Grade students (those who are going into 5th grade in the Fall of 2021)

Counselors: Age 18 and up (graduated high school as of June 2021)

PURPOSE: To provide an environment that will allow the Orthodox youth to learn and grow in their faith while having the time of their life.

HOW IT WORKS THIS YEAR: CSM will operate like a SOYO day, beginning at 4:00 PM and ending at 9:00 PM. Five of the seven sessions will take place at the Basilica, two will take place off campus. See schedule for locations. Dinner and snack will be provided for campers.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

WHAT ABOUT THE ANTIOCHIAN VILLAGE and VILLAGE UP NORTH? Camp St. Mary is not in competition with the Antiochian Village (AV) or Village Up North (VUN) but rather a complimentary program for those who do attend AV and VUN and an option for campers who are not able to attend either camp.

DO I HAVE TO COME EVERY TUESDAY? Well...yes and no. We would love to see campers come to every Tuesday available. However we understand that many take family vacations which are important. We simply ask that you notify us in the application as to any weeks that will be missed due to vacations, AV, or other planned activities. Camp St. Mary should be attended regularly and be considered a priority in the camper's summer schedule. If unexpected circumstances arise that prohibit attendance, please contact CSM ASAP to keep us informed. Even the morning of a camp day is helpful, although 24 hour notice is appreciated.

CAN I BRING A FRIEND? We understand that from time to time you may have visiting relatives or friends that you want to bring along. Even if they are not Orthodox we will accept them with open arms. However, to help with scheduling and logistics, please let us know at least 24 hours in advance by email, phone, or in person.

IS THERE A DRESS CODE? YES! Please come dressed with Christian modesty. This is very important in leaving behind the outside world. Even though most of our activities are casual and swimming is involved, we insist on the most modest apparel. For girls this means NO bikinis or 2-piece swim suits and for guys no tight Speedos please. Also, shorts must be closer to the knees than the top of the thigh, and sleeveless shirts' straps should be at least 2 fingers thick. If you are in doubt of a particular outfit, it would be best to wear something else.

SAFETY AND TRANSPORTATION? ALL TRANSPORTATION WILL BE DONE BY BUS. CSM staff is also first aid and CPR certified.

WHAT ABOUT COVID? CSM will take all necessary precautions to ensure the safety of our campers and staff, and ask that families do the same. This includes staying home if you don't feel well, have a fever, or have been exposed to COVID-19. When checking in, all campers will be asked to wash their hands, use hand sanitizer and answer health screening questions. Most camp activities will take place outdoors, and campers will stay in designated groups. Masks will not be required outdoors. During any indoor activities, including church, masks must be worn at all times, regardless of vaccination status. Campers should bring their own masks and water bottles, labeled with their name. Sharing of water bottles or food between campers and counselors is not allowed.

Campers should be prepared each week for a variety of activities including change of clothes for community service work, swim gear, gym shoes, towels, sun protection, spending money, lunch, and other such supplies that may be needed. Campers will not be permitted to leave to obtain any needed items of clothing or otherwise once the day has begun. NO electronic devices such as cell phones or iPods will be permitted during the camp day.

Please understand that this tuition cost has been calculated to best meet the needs of the family and this program. Although your tuition payments cover the majority of the Camp costs, it does not cover everything. Fundraising efforts have helped to keep the cost as low as possible to each camper. In addition we have done other fundraising projects that help reduce the payments of the individuals who participate. Expenses for this year include any transportation by bus, meals, t-shirts, admission fees, and more.

Can I pay as we go? Yes. While we prefer to have payments made ahead of timing for planning and scheduling activities, we understand that this option is not always available.
